

THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

I. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

II. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

III. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

IV. Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: But the seventh day is the sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

VI. Thou shalt not kill.

VII. Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VIII. Thou shalt not steal.

IX. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

X. Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.

Lesson For Sabbath, April 2, 2022

THE PASSOVER

Scripture Reading: Exodus 12:1-14

Golden Text: John 1:29

1. Why was Israel to keep the Passover? Exodus 12:21-23.
 2. Were they to explain this observance to their children? Exodus 12:26-27.
 3. Was this the only time they were to observe this ordinance? Exodus 12:24.
 4. What happened at midnight? Exodus 11:4-6; 12:29.
 5. How prepared and ready were the Israelites to be when they ate the Passover? Exodus 12:11.
- NOTE: Israel was forewarned and given a time of deliverance. We have been forewarned, but like Jesus, we do not know the day or hour.*
6. How are we to prepare for Christ's return? Mark 13:34-37.
 7. After all the firstborn died, how did Pharaoh and the Egyptians react? Exodus 12:30-36.
 8. Did Israel keep the Passover in the wilderness of Sinai? Numbers 9:1-5.
 9. Was the Passover observed under Joshua? Joshua 5:2-10.
 10. What did Jesus celebrate before He was betrayed in the garden? Matthew 26:17-21.

Lesson For Sabbath, April 9, 2022

THE LORD'S SUPPER

Scripture Reading: Mark 14:12-26

Golden Text: John 6:53

NOTE: In our last lesson, we learned that Christ kept the Passover but after the meal He taught His disciples something new.

1. After the Passover meal what did Jesus do for His disciples? John 13:4-5, 12-17.

NOTE: This act of humility is done before taking the unleavened bread and fruit of the vine.

2. What else is instituted at this time? Luke 22:19-20.

3. Why was Christ's blood shed? Matthew 26:27-28.

4. What else did His blood do for us? Acts 20:28; I Peter 1:18-19.

5. How does Jesus refer to Himself in John 6? John 6:32-35, 48.

6. How important is it to partake of these emblems? John 6:49-53.

7. Why? John 6:54-58.

8. John called Jesus the Lamb of God (John 1:29). But what does Paul call Him? I Corinthians 5:7.

9. What do we memorialize when we come together to keep this Supper? I Corinthians 11:26; Exodus 13:10; Hebrews 10:17-18.

10. Because it is a memorial of Christ's death, what does Paul write about spiritual condition? I Corinthians 11:27-30.

Lesson For Sabbath, April 16, 2022

EGYPT

Scripture Reading: Psalm 81.

Golden Text: Psalm 136:10.

1. Why did Abram go into Egypt? Genesis 12:10.

2. Who came out of Egypt with Abram and what kind of wealth did Abram have? Genesis 13:1-2.

3. How is Sarai's handmaid described in Genesis 16:1-3.

4. When there was another famine in the Land, what was Isaac told? Genesis 26:1-5.

5. What happened to Joseph? Genesis 37:2-4, 27-28.

NOTE: By this time Jacob had become Israel. See Genesis 32:28.

6. How is Israel/Jacob instructed concerning Egypt? Genesis 46:1-4.

7. Was Joseph concerned about his bones remaining in Egypt? Genesis 50:22-26.

8. Were promises kept? Exodus 3:7-8; 12:37-40; 13:19; Joshua 24:31-32; Hebrews 11:22.

9. Did Jesus ever travel to Egypt? Matthew 2:13-15.

10. Was prophecy fulfilled? Hosea 11:1; Exodus 4:22.

Lesson For Sabbath, April 23, 2022

TRAVEL (OF SORTS)

Scripture Reading: Genesis 12:1-10.

Golden Text: Hebrews 11:8.

1. Where was Abram born? Genesis 11:26-28.
 2. Did his family stop on the way to Canaan? Genesis 11:31.
- NOTE: Abram was in Haran when God called him.*
3. While the Israelites walked out of Egypt how does the Lord describe it? Exodus 19:1-2.
 4. How did Israel, the northern ten tribes travel to Assyria? II Kings 17:22-23.
 5. Who replaced them? II Kings 17:24.
 6. Besides Israelites, what else did Nebuchadnezzar carry away to Babylon? II Kings 24:11-16.
 7. Who was used by God to let the people and the Temple vessels return to Jerusalem? Ezra 1:1-4, 7-8.

8. What do we read about Nehemiah? Nehemiah 1:1; 2:1-6.

NOTE: Shushan or Susa was the ancient capital of Persia.

9. Where was Jonah told to do? Jonah 1:1-2.
10. Where did he plan to go? Jonah 1:3.
11. After being cast into the sea, what became his mode of transportation and how long did it take? Jonah 1:15-17.

Lesson For Sabbath, April 30, 2022

PAUL'S TRAVELS

Scripture Reading: Acts 9.

Golden Text: Psalm 86:11.

1. Before Paul came near Damascus, where was he? Acts 7:54, 58-60, to 8:1-3.

NOTE: Paul as Saul was at the stoning of Stephen.

2. Where does he go after his conversion? Acts 9:26-30.
3. What does the church of Antioch do for Paul and Barnabas? Acts 13:1-4.
4. Where did Paul find Timothy? Acts 16:1-5.
5. Who is the first convert in Europe? Acts 16:13-15.
6. Did Paul preach in Thessalonica? Acts 17:1-4; I Thessalonians 1:1-3.
7. Where did those brethren send Paul and Silas? Acts 17:10-11.
8. Because of Jewish opposition, what happened? Acts 17:13-15.
9. While waiting for Silas and Timotheus to join him, what did Paul encounter? Acts 17:16-18.
10. Did Paul give a sermon on Mars' Hill? Acts 17:22-31.
11. How was it received? Acts 17:32-33.

Lesson For Sabbath, May 7, 2022

NOTE: Joppa, now Jaffa, is one of the oldest seaport cities in Israel.

2. Where did Hiram/Hiram plan to send the cut wood? II Chronicles 2:3-4, 15-16.

3. To what city did Peter have to go to meet with the Centurion? Acts 10:23-24.

NOTE: Joppa was approximately 30 miles due south from Caesarea.

4. After the baptism of Cornelius and others, where did Peter go? Acts 11:1-2.

5. When persecution arose about Stephen, what do we read concerning travel? Acts 11:19-20.

6. Where was Paul stoned by the people? Acts 14:19-22.

7. Who expounded the way of God more perfectly to Apollos and where did he go? Acts 18:24-28.

8. After the uproar at Ephesus where did Paul tell the disciples he was going? Acts 20:1-5.

9. Was Paul warned to keep away from Jerusalem? Acts 22:17-24.

10. When Paul appealed to Caesar, where was he taken? Acts 26:27-32, 27:1,16.

5. Why? Mark 8:35-38.

6. How does Paul beseech us in Ephesians? Ephesians 4:1-3. And in Corinthians? I Corinthians 4:16.

7. What does the Apostle write to the Colossians and by extension, to us today? Colossians 1:9-10.

8. Does Paul encourage the Philippians? Philippians 3:17.

9. When writing to the Thessalonians of what does he remind them? I Thessalonians 2:9-13.

10. In the Gospel of Matthew Peter asks a direct question of the Lord. Matthew 19:27-28.

11. Everyone else? Matthew 19:29.

NOTE: The "travel" or walk of a child of God is specific. Let us not waver or vary. See Matthew 7:13-14.

ANOINTINGS, GIFTS AND PRESENTS

Scripture Reading: I Kings 10:1-13.

Golden Text: Proverbs 19:6.

1. What gifts were presented to Jesus at His birth? Matthew 2:7-11.

NOTE: Frankincense is gum resin from an African tree and burned as incense but also used in perfumes.

2. Where else do we find frankincense? Exodus 30:30-35; Leviticus 2:1-2.

3. Was frankincense used on a sin offering? Leviticus 5:1, 5-7, 11.

4. What did Israel tell his sons to take with them when they returned to Egypt? Genesis 43:1-2, 11-12.

NOTE: Myrrh is also from tree gum resin and used for incense.

5. The Psalmist writes of Myrrh. Psalm 45:6-8.

6. Did Mary anoint Jesus' feet? John 12:1-3.

7. After Jesus died what did Nicodemus bring with him? John 19:38-39.

8. Did the women have to prepare spices and ointments? Luke 23:50-56; 24:1.

9. What did Mary Magdalene and another Mary bring to the tomb? Mark 16:1.

10. How else is Jesus anointed? Hebrews 1:8-9.

Lesson For Sabbath, May 28, 2022

SOLOMON VS JESUS

Scripture Reading: I Kings 3:1-15.
